The light we lost synopsis

The young adult novel *The Light We Lost* by Jill Santopolo is one of the few novels of its kind that puts your mind about the protagonist in a new perspective. While I truly enjoy reading this novel because of how I write, I have a hard time not wanting to change the protagonist Lucy Carter. While most protagonists are seen as good heroes, among other positive features, Lucy is not the same case. Her decision made her more insidious from her own story than she realized. Lucy was a senior at Columbia University when she met Gabriel (Gabe), a young man she immediately fell in love with. Beware: This isn't your typical 'love story', it raises the question of whether fate or freedom will define your way of life. *The Light We Lost* by Jill Santopolo.Lucy and Gabriel met on the tragic day of September 11, 2001 (9/11), as they both saw the chaos and despair the events of the day had caused them to kiss, highlighting their craving to live here and now.
